Objectives.

Our aims are to benefit and promote the interests of our members in a social capacity

Rules.

The Association shall comprise of members who have joined together for the benefit of the Association and for no other reason.

Membership.

Membership of the Association will be open to any person who is a retired Police Officer of any national Police Service, Spouses and Partner's, widows and widowers of such officers.

Subscriptions.

An annual subscription will be set at the AGM and will be payable in the January of each year

Voting.

All paid up members will be eligible to vote on any issue or proposal either in person or by proxy.

AGM. Nominations for officers will be accepted from opening of the January meeting and close at the end of that meeting. Allowing the secretary to arrange any ballot papers

Management of the Branch.

Members voting at the AGM will elect a managing committee comprising of

Chairman. Deputy Chairman.

Secretary Deputy Chairman.

Treasurer Deputy Treasurer

Together with any other posts the membership deems necessary. This includes an Information officer and a Social Secretary.

Term of office will be for one year.

The treasurer will be responsible for the financial management of the association. He will present a monthly balance sheet and a full financial statement at the AGM.

Expenses and Honorarium

Reasonable expenses incurred by a member with the approval of the treasurer whilst acting for the Association will be met. An itemised receipt should be submitted giving a breakdown of the expenses incurred.

A single payment not exceeding €50 will be payable for any projected expenses such as travelling expenses incurred within one Association year.

Meetings

The Committee will set the Time, date, and Venue of the monthly meetings.

Guests.

Visiting Police officers are welcome to attend the monthly meeting and may attend as a guest, any social function that is planned.

These rules are to be used by the Committee for the management of the Association.

Any member at an AGM may propose any amendment to an existing rule, or propose a new rule. All such proposals must be seconded. All paid up members will be eligible to vote.

Disbandment of the Association.

The association may be disbanded at an AGM or Extraordinary meeting by a majority vote in favour which must be a two thirds majority of the members present. All efforts should be made to contact non resident members, and any that may not be attending the meeting.

The meeting should also vote on the disposal of any surplus funds after all outstanding debts have been met, any remaining money will then be donated to a local cancer charity
